The Coast Live Oak (aka California Live Oak) is a long-lived native evergreen tree which grows wild from northern Baja California along the coast to Mendocino county. This is a "keystone" species which supports a rich diversity of native wildlife (including native bees, butterflies, birds, etc..). It is the predominant species in our local oak woodlands.
